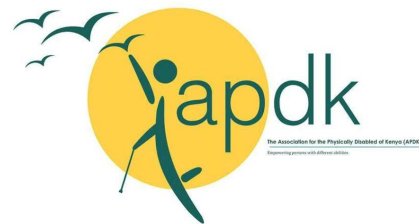
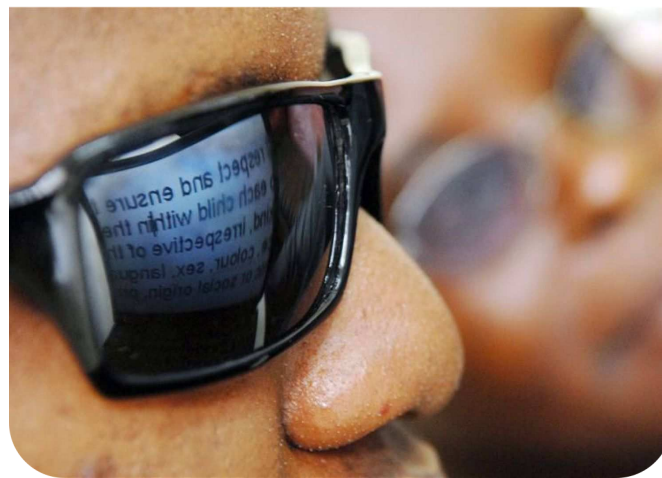


Affirm the rights of Persons with Disabilities

Prioritise Persons with Disabilities

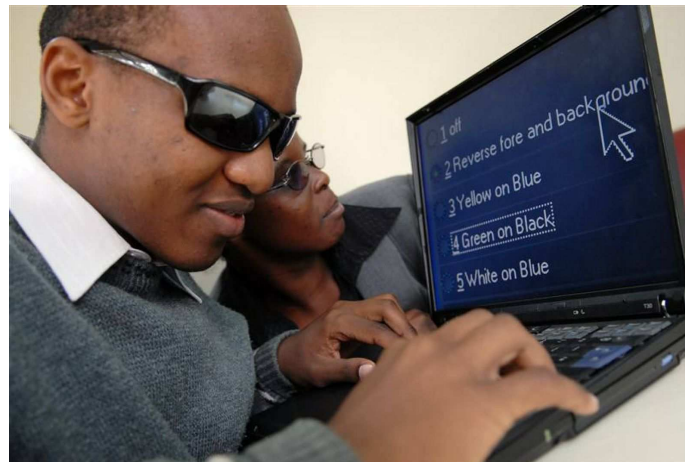
